Thank you for your past and future support of *Centennial* Little League. With you, and support from within the community, our league has grown into something our entire community is proud of. We provide baseball and softball for the most important citizens in our area: our children.

We would like to take a moment to share some history of Centennial Little League. Founded in 1961, the league was originally named *Meadowland Little League* with the ball fields located on the property of Meadowland Dairy at the intersection of SE 162nd and Powell Blvd. As a result of development of Meadowland Dairy's property, the Little League lost the use of the land for their fields. In 1984, our local Little League moved to its current location, SE 182nd just south of Division, on property owned by Centennial School District, thus establishing the name ***Centennial Little League***. Though Centennial School District leases the land to us we are 100% responsible for all costs associated with the program, including maintenance of the fields and buildings, and funds used to purchase uniforms, equipment and functional supplies.

Centennial Little League is a non-profit organization dedicated to teaching life skills through sports in a healthy environment for the youths in our community. *Centennial* Little League offers boys **and** girls ages 5 to 18 the opportunity to play baseball, softball, or T-ball regardless of skill level or financial ability. We also offer a Challenger program at no cost for children ages 5-18, a program specifically for those with mental or physical disabilities. No child is ever turned away. It is too important that every child gets a chance to play. Little League and our great community take this very seriously. This is why you, our partner/sponsors, are so valuable.

Last year from March to August, *Centennial* Little League provided an opportunity for nearly 400 boys & girls to not only play ball, but also to learn lifelong skills such as sportsmanship, humility, fair play, and pride in the community. With the cancellation of freshmen spring sports at CHS, we will be there to provide those wanting to participate the opportunity to continue playing baseball and softball. Our kids have many choices to make every day and some are less than positive. As a community we owe it to our children to provide a safe, positive environment and a good sporting experience, where 'peer pressure' results in kids pushing each other to make good decisions. **Through continued hard work and dedication, 2009 again saw Centennial's Honors and All-Star teams having great success in their tournaments with several becoming District 2 Champions.** Though there was undeniable joy & satisfaction in winning, the positive impact it had within other members of our community was overwhelming. With positive role models, volunteers and your partnership, *Centennial* Little League will continue to grow and be a driving influence in the development of the lives of our young people.

In order to provide the most positive and safe experience for all our kids, it is necessary not only to sustain but to constantly improve equipment and facilities.
